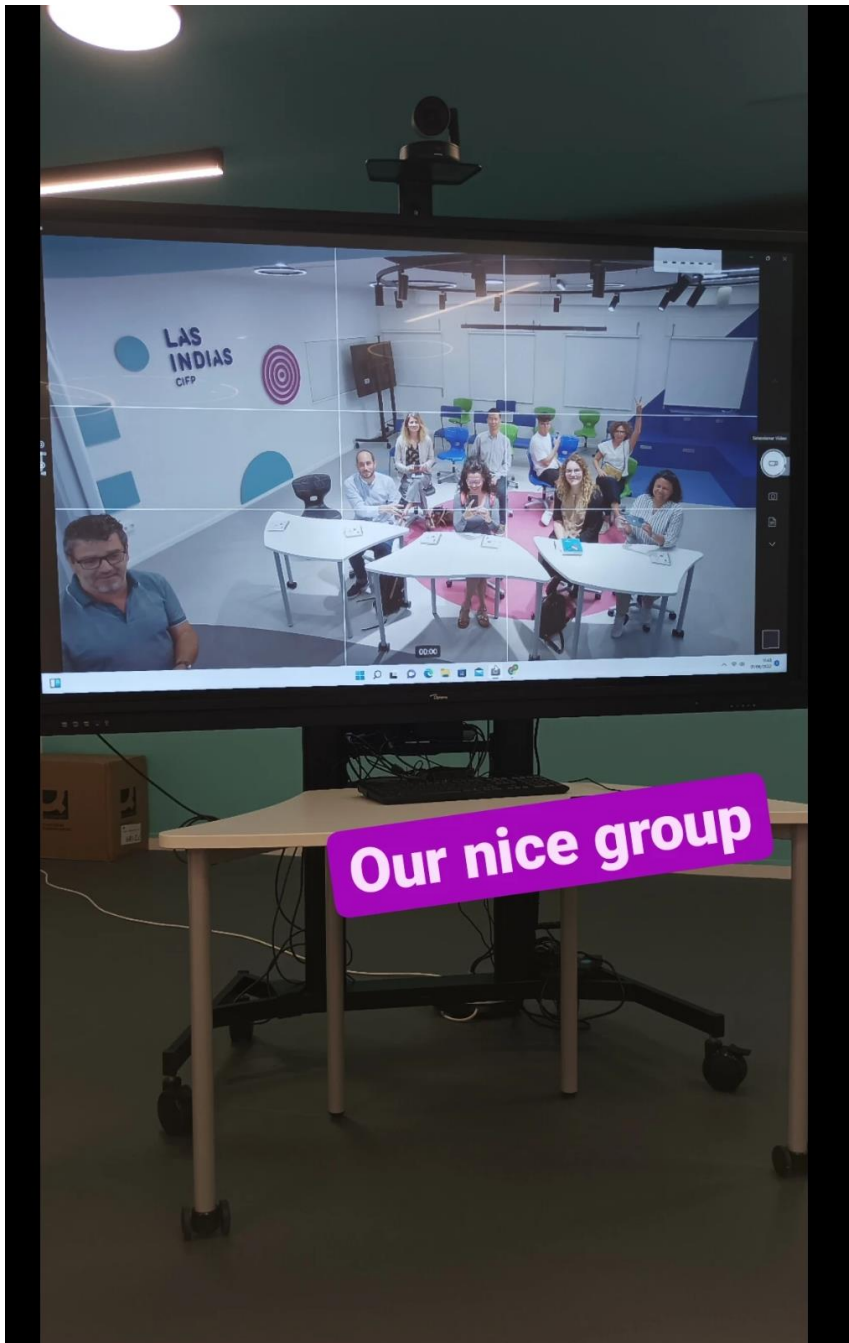

- At 11.30 we visited the Hotel Hovima La Pinta. They receive more than 20 students every year.



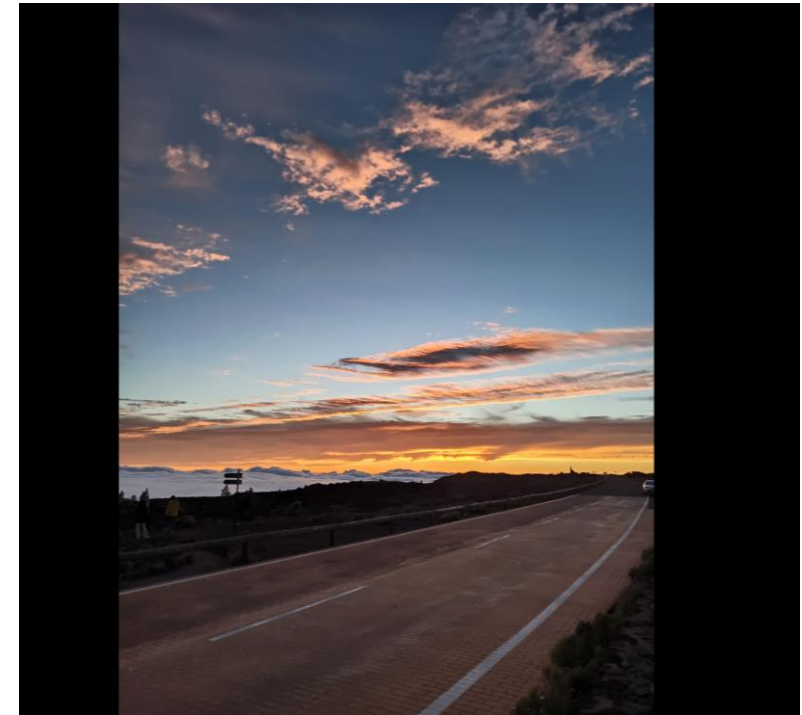
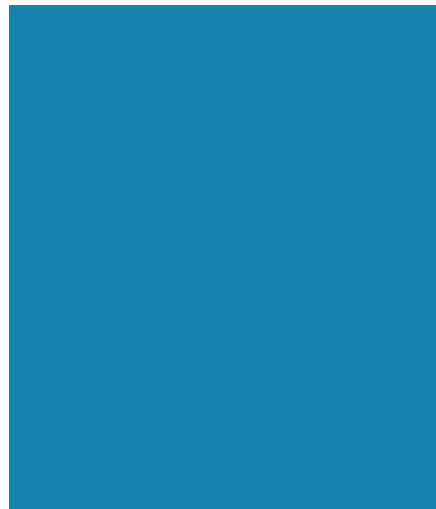
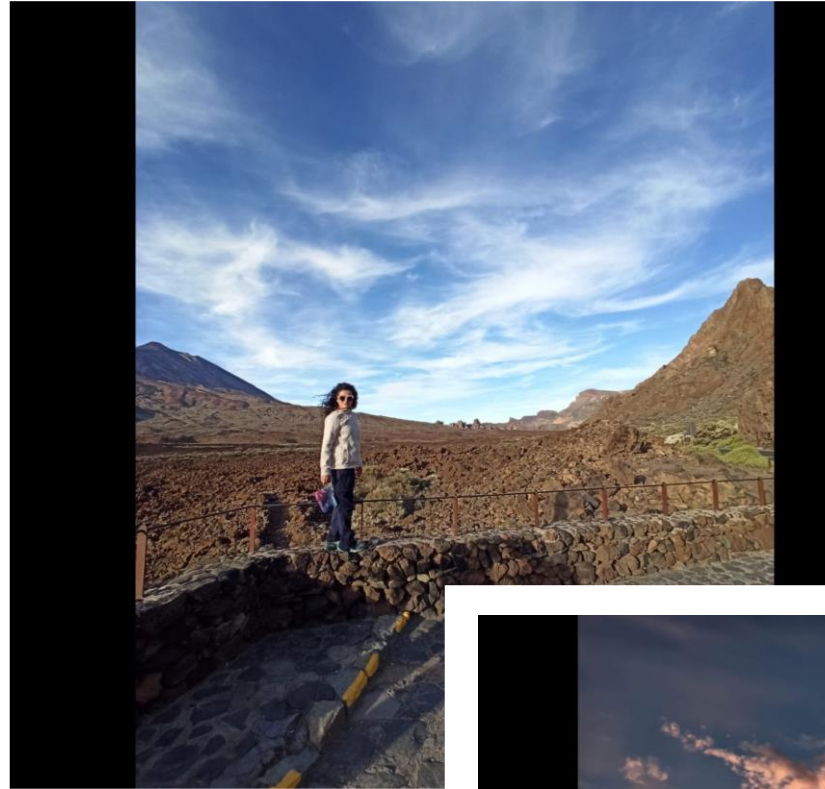

Cultural trip on the Teide

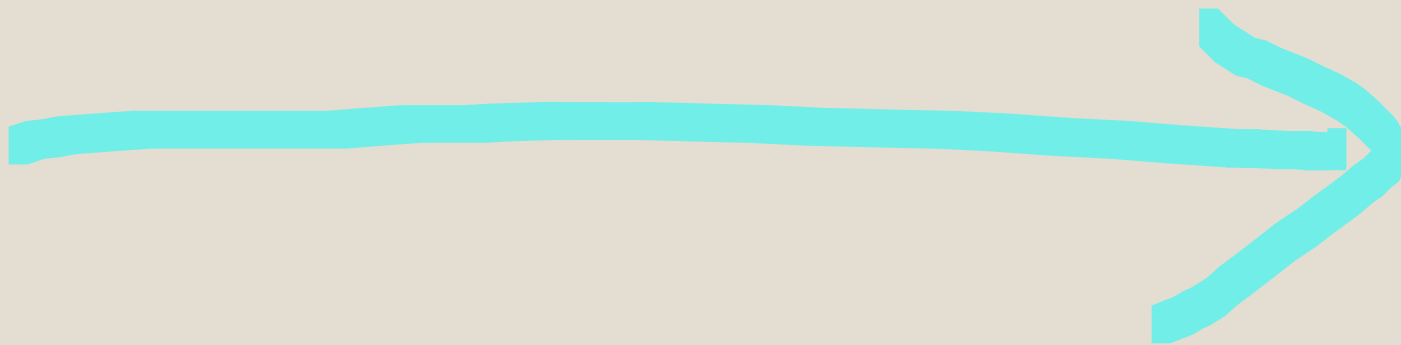




It was an important experience, I have learnt new things and also visited the island a lot.
