# ERASMUS project: Latine disco.

## 1. Description of the project:

The goal of this project is to learn or revise the Latin language while discovering Roman civilization and history. It will therefore be a question of offering Latin language lessons and exercises on the e-Twinning platform. The teachers participating in the project will propose exercises typical of their country in order to compare the different ways of teaching the Latin language according to the different European countries. Students will be able to experience different practices.

It will thus be a question of creating a manual of European Latin.

### 2. Procedures:

Apart from mobility: work on the language from the e-Twinning site.

A Latin language lesson translated into Latin AND/OR English.

On the same lesson, proposals for exercises classified according to three levels:

- \*beginners
- \*\*confirmed
- \*\*\*expert

Student activities per lesson:

- 1) Read the course
- 2) Do the exercises by drawing from the exercises proposed by each teacher
- 3) Propose imitation exercises with the solutions

Teacher activities:

- 1) Propose a lesson on the theme
- 2) Propose a beginner exercise, a confirmed exercise, an expert exercise.

Class evaluations will be made from the exercises on the page.

The students' exercise proposals will be noted as a bonus note.

The goal is online collaborative work from the e-Twinning site.

Work in teams to create exercises, multiple choice questions, flashcards.

Use of various websites for the exercises.

#### During mobility:

Elaboration of the civilizations pages of the manual according to the specificities of the regions of the participants in the project and the remarkable sites.

Example: Charente Maritime: town of Saintes: the arenas, the arch of Germanicus, the aqueducts, the thermal baths.

## 3. Goals:

- Sharing of practice between teachers.
- Complementary courses for students.
- Mastery of internet tools.
- Progression in the languages of the project but also in English / Latin for the exercise lessons which are offered in both languages.
- Become aware of the permanence of the teaching of Latin and its differences depending on the country.
- Create a community of European Latinists.
- Carry out studies on the facts of civilization among the partners: highlight the different regions of the project.
